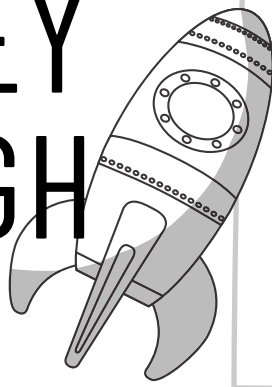


JOURNEY THROUGH SPACE

Challenge 1. Create a Spaceship for your trip!

- Use recycled materials to build a model of your ship
- Draw a picture of your ship
- Write a detailed description of your spaceship

Challenge 2. Time to pack! Pick 3 items to take with you that you will use to explain your life on Earth to the aliens you meet.

- Take a picture of your items
- Draw a picture of your items
- Write a description of your items

Challenge 3. KAPOW! Your space ship blasted off but it sent you into a Comic Book Universe! WOAH! Create a 1 page comic showing us how you escaped.

- Draw it out! Use pencils, pens, crayons, markers, or digital drawing tools.

Challenge 4. Tell us about the planet you are going to visit on your journey. Is it in our solar system? Is it around another star? What is it like? You could research an actual planet or exoplanet - or design your own!

- Write a detailed description of the planet
- Build a model of the planet
- Draw a picture of the planet

Challenge 5. You've passed the half-way point of your journey, so you stop at a spaceport to refuel. While there, you meet an alien from another universe. They are studying myths from other worlds and they ask you to tell them a myth from Earth.

- In your own words, write down the myth as you would tell it to the alien
- Draw a picture that you will use to tell the myth to the alien
- Read a myth aloud to an adult and then take a picture of the two of you

Challenge 6. You finally arrive at the planet you want to visit but they won't let you land until you tell them the coded phrase below! Luckily you are an expert code breaker and you know that SPACE is written in this code as 19-16-1- 3-5. (Hint - if you wind up totally stumped, email summerreading@tnrd.ca or call your friendly Library staff for help!)
