Write a story together! Have your child draw the pictures and you write the words. Read it together!	Sing and dance to a favourite song together!	Tell a story to/with your child where they are the main character!	Read a non-fiction book together. There are lots of non-fiction picture books and board books!	Doing animal walks is lots of fun! Make the noises of the animals as you walk about acting like them.
Practice writing letters and words with finger paint, or by tracing letters in a tray of salt.	Sing a song with lots of actions together! Maybe Zoom Zoom or Wheels on the Bus?	Practice having a conversation with your child. Take turns talking (even if they can't talk yet).	Read a story together when the stars are out. (Or read under a blanket with a flashlight)	Pretend you're an astronaut! Talk about the things you see on your spacewalk.
Write a grocery list together and talk about the things you need to buy.	Sing a song to help with a daily activity, like washing your hands, getting dressed, or going to bed.		Read a familiar story together and make up a new ending!	Act out a favourite story together. Use toys, action figures, costumes, or yourselves as props!
Write a letter together to a loved one. (You may need to "translate" what your child writes for the recipient!)	Sing a lullaby at bed time.	Read a book with your child and talk about the pictures with them!	Cook something together and read the recipe together out loud as you go.	Play a game together! Maybe it's peek-a-boo, hopscotch, or an actual boardgame.
